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## **Expectations of all members:-**

1. That they complete an application form and provide a reference.

2. That they have had an arranged with conversation with a designated SWVG member (Recruitment and Training)

3. That they visit the Multicultural Centre at ASA if at all possible, to meet members of the Friday Team, other members and usually one or two clients.

4. That they attend a Welcome Evening to understand something of asylum issues, SWVG's ethos, how we work and to get some written information (Annual Review etc.)

5. That they attend Part 1 of the Training Programme and are strongly advised to do the full training as this provides them with a good insight into how we work and what we do.

6. If they wish to be a visitor, they must be DBS checked, and attend the whole of the Training Programme and its requirements (e.g. attend support group, produce regular updates about their client etc.).

7. That they have a designated role in SWVG.

8. That they are supported/mentored/monitored in their role. If a visitor, by the Coordinators and if a group member/non visitor, by Anne Leeming and/or an-other.

9. Ensure that all information about clients in kept in strictest confidence.
